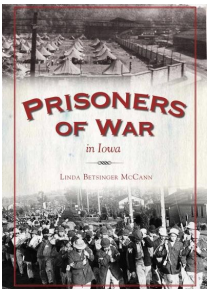

## Cultural Literacy: Understanding Civility

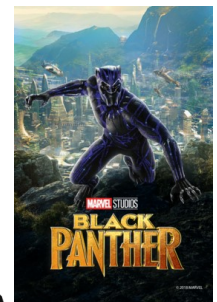
Wednesday, March 20, 7:00-8:00 pm, Meeting Room

As of April 15, the library will start charging a \$2.00 fee for each Interlibrary Loan item. This fee will be used to offset postage for Interlibrary Loan Materials.

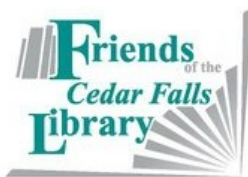
