Try At Home:

Make a number activity path. With chalk, on the sidewalk or driveway, write an activity for the kids to do a certain number of times. For example, turn in a circle 1 time, jump 2 times, clap your hands 3 times, etc. Have your kids walk the path and do the activities to practice their counting.

We Sang:

1, 2, 3 Whee! by Eric Litwin and Michael Levine

STEAM Tip:

Allowing kids to move and use their bodies while doing STEAM activities engages different parts of their brains. Kids also have better recall when they are participating in a hands on activity over a passive activity.
