WE SANG:

FINGERPLAY:

My hands upon my head I'll place.

Now see how quiet they can be.

LITERACY TIP:

When we talk with our children, even our young children, about factual information, we help them learn about the world. This introduces them to the background knowledge they will need to later understand what they read. Even if they do not understand everything we say, it is still important to share the information with them.(source: Ghoting)
