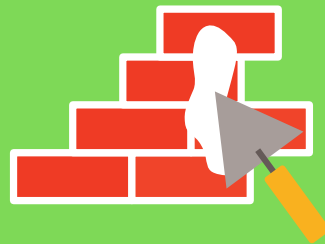
We're tapping with our sticks,
