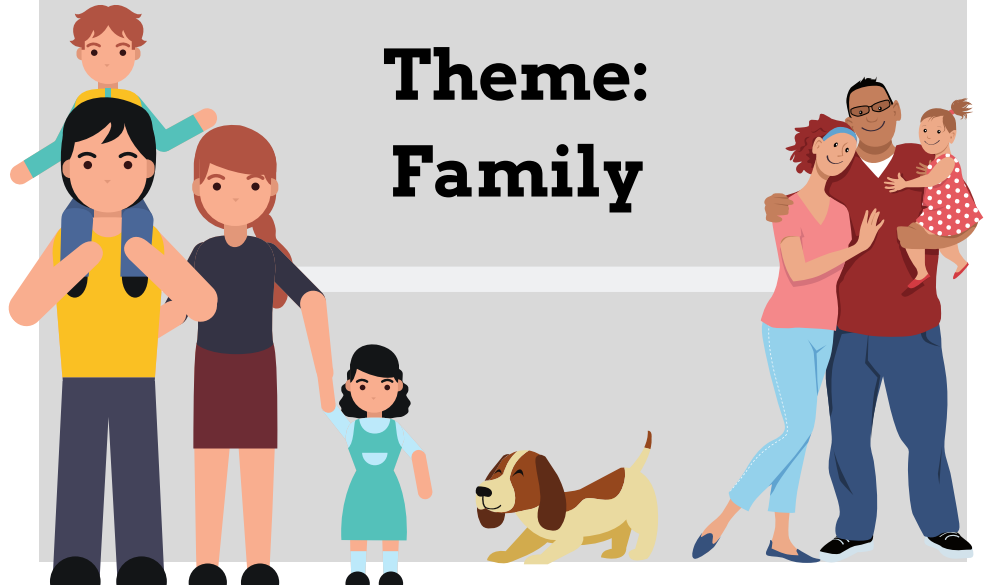

LITERACY TIP:

Songs have words not heard in every day conversation with young children ("fetch" in the song/ rhyme Jack and Jill). Many songs help children with concepts such as opposites, size, shapes. While singing favorite or new songs, explain words or give synonyms to unknown words.

TRY AT HOME:

Have a family sing-along. Each person gets to pick a favorite song.
